McL&H implement new glove policy

**After March 31st
Your Old Gloves
Won't Cut It.**



From March 31st 2016 everyone on site will be required to wear gloves which provide Cut Level 5 Protection. Make sure you're protected.

From 1 March 2016 all McLaughlin & Harvey employees and direct labour will be required to wear a minimum of cut level 5 hand protection, with everyone on-site compliant from 31 March 2016.

Over the past few months we have been reviewing our glove policy and have been working with glove manufacturers and suppliers to identify suitable gloves which will provide the maximum protection to operatives and still allow them the dexterity to carry out their works.

Following successful site trials McLaughlin & Harvey is now in a position to update our glove policy to specify that all gloves on-site meet a minimum of cut level 5 projection for all projects.
